Roll Up for the Tour: Roadrunner Food Bank Onsite Facility Projects Explored at September Visit

lan today to join the Facility Manager Association of New Mexico at 7 am on Wednesday morning, September 20, 2017, for Blake's Burritos, Starbucks Coffee, and OJ before we take a journey through the infrastructural upgrades capably executed by Chief Operations Officer, Teresa Johansen, at the Roadrunner Food Bank, 5840 Office Boulevard NE in Albuquerque, NM. Arrive on time to eat, and wear your walking shoes as we launch into inner space for an onsite adventure!



Learn about these impressive and sweeping project savings:

Water: \$12,000- \$7000: All savings on landscaping by going from grass to xeriscaping; paid for by water rebate "Keeping New Mexico Beautiful" grant. Work completed by volunteers and the plan provided for free by Heads Up Landscaping.

Heating Oil: \$27,000 - \$22,000: Using a gas reseller like "Tiger" and warehouse insulation (private grant) and also a new roof of white TPO.

Fleet fuel: 12%-17% improvement in fuel/mile on a \$300,000 fuel bill, paid for with an EPA "Clean Air Grant", an annual grant that is open to any business. Utilizing low profile tires, fairings on cab, and under trailer. Routing software used for route optimization.

Trash/Recycling: \$100,000 year trash costs lowered to \$30,000 year plus \$30,000 on recycling income. Paid for with the "RAID" grant and "Keeping New Mexico Beautiful" recycling grant. All food is used: people first, then animals, and then composting. Packaging materials are baled: cardboard, stretch wrap, white paper, cans. Pallets sold to highest bidder.

Electricity: \$180,000 year down to ??? thanks to various projects: PNM "Reduce Your Use": forklift charger upgrades, forklift charger timing, new washers and driers, window tinting. Installation of a new cooler/freezer doors (PNM Rebate). New warehouse lighting (40% savings) on motion sensors and motion sensors in all offices and hallways. Exit signage using LEDs. New HVAC units; test and balance of ducting; programmable thermostats.

Solar: PPA with Affordable Solar, 366 kWh array turned on December 18, 2016; savings \$21,000 in the first 6 months; expansion planned.

Demand Reduction Battery system: PPA with Affordable Solar; new technology still unproven; will charge night, deploy when needed. Potential to save \$2500/month.
