Brewing and Beverage Management program, rallied the troops on the many offerings the college has which are specific to this industry.

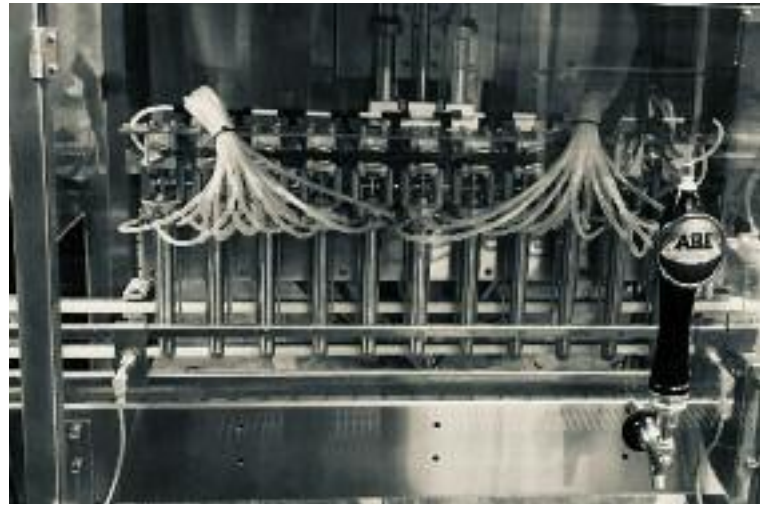
